When a parent and teen register for the app, the parent's email links the two accounts, and they can then complete ActionPoints.









Parents and teens complete ActionPoints, which are a series of interaction-based app modules where parents and teens engage in evidence-




Comparison of Your Answers: SocialMediaTimeFrame On an average day, how many hours do you spend on social media? T: 4 hours or more
